- OUR DAILY BREAD** - St. Charles participates monthly in feeding the poor of our city
- ADOPT-A-ROAD** - St. Charles cares for God's creation in Pikesville with quarterly clean ups of Old Court Road
- ST VINCENT DE PAUL** - Answering the call to serve the poor, activities include the Christmas Food Baskets, clothing bin, and donations for emergency utility and rental assistance throughout the year
- GIVING TREE** - Help to coordinate needs, prepare tags/ornaments, set up the tree, collect and even deliver the gifts that are collected each year during Advent for those in need
- SILVERLINERS** - Senior members meet through the year, developing fellowship and understanding of St. Charles community needs
- SODALITY** - St. Charles chapter of devotion to service in Mother Mary's name
- FINANCE** - Includes fundraising planning and events for the parish, including upcoming Bazaar, quarterly dinners, invited speakers
- BUILDING & MAINTENANCE** - From the routine care of our church interior, or the regular exterior care of our grounds, through the longer term planning for construction, painting and renovation, these volunteers extend the care of St. Charles and help ensure a safe, secure place of worship now and in our future
- QUILTERS** - Regular meetings of volunteers find fellowship as they design and create unique donations for Bazaar and other St. Charles fundraising events
- EUCCHARISTIC MINISTRY** - Trained volunteers bring Christ to homebound and nursing facilities, as well as assist at all Masses at St. Charles
- LITURGY** - St. Charles parishioners make our liturgy celebrations meaningful with many ways to participate, from training and planning to actually doing. Includes our parish music ministry, ministry to our deaf community, CLOW, environmental contributions, altar servers, lectors, and ushers
- HOSPITALITY** - St. Charles volunteers continue to find ways to build our community, with outreach to new parishioners and support to our existing parishioners
